

Sr Warden's Report December 2021

Formation

We concluded our participation in Adult Formation with All Saints Vista – *Luke the Liberator*. Two Holy Cross members and one friend of Holy Cross participated. The possible Advent program with Mtr. Susan Astarita did not come to fruition due to timing. Godly Play resumed December 5th – the leaders contacted past Godly Play families to make sure they knew and to make sure they knew about Brian being appointed as Clergy-in-Charge. The Ho family kids were the only children to participate.

Outreach

Wounded Warriors continues to deliver healthy snacks monthly under Tom Mauro's faithful leadership. All Saints Cemetery Clean-up continues under Katie Ho's faithful leadership. *Operation Secret Santa*, our Advent Outreach program, benefiting the children of the Wounded Warrior Battalion - West based at Camp Pendleton, was a great success. Tom estimates there were close to 1,000 gifts donated by Holy Cross and several neighboring organizations and Holy Cross donated 500 of those - wow!!!!

Visioning Ministry

The Visioning Ministry team meet on Sunday, December 12th and the various teams reported on their progress. The Drafting Group shared their work on the Mission, Vision and Values – after much discussion they had lots of feedback for continued work. We meet again January 23rd with an additional assignment for three newly formed groups to create a “Cover Story Vision” of Holy Cross 5 years in the future.

Our 2022 pledge campaign, *Forward Together*, ended on November 14th. received 26 of the 60 pledge cards mailed with pledges totaling \$97,268 towards our goal of \$185,000.
