In-car worship plan, Holy Cross Episcopal Church

When you arrive at the Holy Cross parking lot, an usher wearing a face covering will direct you toward parking spaces in front of the church. Select your parking space, and park your car facing the church. An usher, wearing a face covering and gloves, will provide a worship booklet, and verify each person in your car. The ushers will maintain a contact list of all who attend. If you bring a guest, it will be necessary to obtain their contact information. Ushers will continue to wear masks if they are outside their own cars. If your windows are up, and remain up, you do not need to wear a mask. If you are too warm or cold, use your A/C or car heater. If your windows are down, no matter how slightly, you must wear a mask. Your participation in the service will occur inside your car, there will be no requirement for you to leave your car or enter the church during the service. The service will be broadcast over the FM band on your car radio, and a frequency will be provided. Fr Richard will conduct the service outside, from a platform in front of the church. For the time being, communion will not be offered. When the service is concluded worshippers are expected to drive away.

Notes:

The service booklet will only be handled by persons wearing a mask and gloves, first when it comes from the copy machine, and then when it is handed to you. It will go home with you.

In the unlikely event the FM signal is not strong enough, or is lost, ushers will inform you of the new frequency. If you have difficulty finding the FM frequency, flash your turn signals, and a masked usher will assist you.

If it is necessary for you to enter the church building you must wear a mask, and use hand sanitizer found inside the front door. At this time people attending church services in their cars are discouraged from entering the building.

Ushers: Make arrangements to pick up the worship booklets at the church. Wearing a face mask, guide worshippers toward parking spaces. Wearing both a mask and gloves, deliver the worship booklet(s) to each car. Use a Congregational Roster to record attendees. Obtain contact information from visitors, to include a phone number and address. Ensure a small quantity of masks are available for worshippers who do not have one. Be prepared to assist those who have any difficulty with tuning in the FM broadcast. Assist Rev. Richard in setting up the platform, and audio/visual equipment.

Facilities manager: Be prepared to assist Rev. Richard and the ushers in setting up the platform and the audio/visual equipment.
