

BOUNDLESS WASHINGTON

OVERVIEW

Boundless Washington is an equity-focused program that integrates fun, challenging outdoor activities with leadership training for young people with disabilities in Washington state. At capacity, the program will sponsor 20 middle and high school students to participate in the program. Launched in 2020, the program currently serves 9 students all over the state.

PROGRAMMING

OUTDOOR RECREATION: The backbone of the two-year Boundless Washington program is a series of 7 annual weekend outdoor excursions featuring activities such as skiing, hiking, camping, and more.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING: Integrated into each excursion is a leadership development curriculum developed by the nationally-recognized leadership non-profit organization, No Barriers. In addition to in-person training, Boundless Washington also includes online leadership training to keep students engaged between excursions.
