

GROW A GRASS HEAD

SUPPLIES:



Plastic Cups



Water



Potting Soil or Dirt



Scissors



Grass Seeds



Hot Glue Gun



Construction Paper



Hot Glue

CHALLENGE:

Grow a grass head.
Monitor its progress,
and give it haircuts!



GROW A GRASS HEAD SET UP

STEP 1: Fill the cups about 3/4 full of soil.

STEP 2: Sprinkle enough seeds on top to cover the soil. Do not cover the seeds with more soil.

STEP 3: Place in a sunny window inside of your house.

STEP 4: Water the seed cups morning and night.

STEP 5: The seeds will take about a week to start growing.

STEP 6: Once you have long grass, you can cut out a nose, mouth and eyes from the colored construction paper.

STEP 7: Glue the nose, mouth, and eyes on the front of the cups. The grass will act as hair.

STEP 8: Once the grass is overgrown, give them a "haircut".
