

DESIGN & BUILD A SIMPLE BIRD FEEDER

The birds are hungry and waiting for food!
Design and build a feeder.



STEPS:

1. Think of ideas for building a bird feeder.
2. Draw your designs.
3. Once you decide on a design, build your bird feeder and add seeds, nuts, and other edible materials that birds enjoy.
4. Hang your bird feeder outside for the birds to enjoy.

Bonus: Think of a clever way to make it squirrel proof.

Possible Supplies: toothpicks, craft sticks, skewers, fabric, string LEGO® bricks, wooden planks, twist ties, zip ties, twine, craft paper, glue, paint, stickers, ribbon, glue, seeds, flowers, nuts, peanut butter



KNOW IT, TEST IT, WRITE IT

Test it: Once you have built your birdfeeder, place it outside for the birds to enjoy. Hang it somewhere near a window so you can observe the birds that come to your feeder.

Two times a day for one week, morning and evening, watch for the birds to come to your feeder. Count the number of birds you see each time.
