Self Help Inc.'s **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)** program provides **FREE** income tax preparation and assistance to households with an income of generally less than \$55,000 a year.

VITA is a safe, simple way to file your taxes and keep more of your hard-earned income in your pocket!!



Let Self Help Inc.'s trained volunteers help you determine if you qualify for the **Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)**. This credit is for working individuals whose income falls below the guidelines listed:

What to Bring to Your Appointment:

- Proof of identification (photo ID)(driver's license, Mass ID, Passport)
- Social Security cards for you, your spouse and dependents. **An Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) assignment letter may be substituted for you, your spouse and your dependents if you do not have a Social Security number**
- Proof of foreign status, if applying for an ITIN
- Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return
- Wage and earning statements (Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R,1099-Misc) from all employers
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)
- Health Insurance Exemption Certificate, if received
- A copy of your federal and state returns from last year, if available
- Proof of bank account routing and account numbers for direct deposit such as a blank check
- To file taxes electronically on a married-filing-joint tax return, **both spouses must be present to sign the required forms**
- Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax identifying number such as their Social Security number or business Employer Identification Number
- Forms 1095-A, B and C, Health Coverage Statements
- Copies of income transcripts from IRS and state, if applicable
