

Our Quality Blue Condition Assessment Program is Launching

Our new Quality Blue – Condition Assessment Program (QB-CAP) is rolling out in 2025. QB-CAP will eliminate the use of paper forms and simplify incentives for annual wellness visits. It will also offer opportunities to assess the identified health conditions of your Blue Advantage patients.

With QB-CAP, Blue Advantage providers treating Blue Advantage members can earn additional payments for completing Annual Wellness Visits and accurately and comprehensively assessing conditions.

2025 QB-CAP Payment Opportunities

- Earn \$60 payment per completed Annual Wellness Visit with a Blue Advantage member.
- Additional payment opportunities available for condition assessments of Blue Advantage members.

To be eligible for participation, providers must fully comply with program requirements and:

- Participate in the Blue Advantage network.
- Practice within one (1) of the following eligible specialties:
 - Family medicine
 - Internal medicine
 - Geriatric medicine
 - General practice physicians
 - Pediatricians
 - Physician assistants (PA)*
 - Nurse practitioners (NP)*

There are no exceptions to the inclusion of Blue Advantage members in QB-CAP.
