You gave Gayla hope and helped save a life for eternity

When the pregnancy test read "positive," Gayla "felt the tears spring to her eyes. She and her boyfriend Jacob already had two kids and barely made ends meet. Could they support another baby? Jacob agreed with her doubts. We just don't make enough money as it is," he said to her sorrowfully. Together they concluded an abortion was their only choice.*

Researching that day Gayla found Daybreak Pregnancy Resource Center, and called hoping they could help her. We just can't afford another baby right now," she said numbly.

As the coach carefully explained the factual details of various abortion procedure's, Gayla's distress grew, she did not feel at peace about any of it. The coach told Gayla about the support through Daybreak and other pregnancy centers, The coach gave Gayla the directions to the center.

*When the coach began to gently switch gears and share the gospel, Gayla felt something open inside her. The simple truth of the gospel pricked at her in a way she never thought it could. Receptive to the words of truth and grace, Gayla opened her heart to the Lord and prayed with the coach to accept him as her Lord and Savior! Relief flooded over her almost immediately and she felt something else she hadn't in a long time: **Hope.***

Heathers parents was having a lot of financial problems and told her they could not help her raise the child. The distraught teen was not the only one struggling with the decision, the baby's father called Daybreak wanting to know how he could talk to Heathers parents! Information from the pregnancy coach gave him the courage he needed to join the conversation and fight for his unborn child. They met together and both families worked out a Life Plan to save the baby!
