A message from Our Executive Director



Dear Friends now that 2023 has come to an end and we start 2024 New Year, I wanted to let you know that my staff and I are praying that your children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren will have a safe, healthy, and enjoyable year 2024.

We ended 2023 and are ready for a great and rewarding year in 2024. We are on a mission and outreach to service our communities, Dooly, Wilcox, and Crisp Counties.

Daybreak Center is a locally organized and funded volunteer ministry demonstrating the love of Jesus Christ by providing services to Mothers to be and existing parents and children. We service clients by addressing their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs. We also strive to provide accurate and complete information on prenatal development for their un born child and parenting classes for the existing children. We believe access to this information is needed to assure they have the parenting skills to help with raising their children. Our ministry to women, children, and all families who come inside our doors is to share the love of Jesus Christ.

Each day we gain a better understanding of how we can most effectively serve our communities. I think it is important to share some numbers so you can get a picture of the activity in the year of 2023.

- *We had 163 families/clients 2023*
- *28 pregnancy test-23 positive and 5 negatives*
- *We serviced 134 families with children from birth to 17 years of age with clothing, shoes, food, and school supplies, other needs*
- *We assisted with two families homeless- with a home and what they needed, including clothing, food and moral support*
- *Our Earn While You learn Program, (Parenting Classes, 31 men and women completed classes, this allows parents to shop in the baby stores, they earn points for each class and shop with the points they earned*
- *Each of our new born babies were furnished with everything needed, including baby furniture*
- *after the baby arrives, we continue to supply diapers from new born to size 6, we furnish formula when we have available, we continue 2 years after the birth of the child*
- *Daybreak Christmas for Children, we had 63 children, who woke up on Christmas morning and had Christmas toys, clothing, and other items*
- *Two completed on the job training, through Eckerd Connects*
- *We have a volunteer (retired teacher) that helps men an woman with studies to get their GED, We have success stories, one young lady achieved her GED and walked across the stage and received her diploma, she will continue her education, in Early Childhood*
- *12 person's completed community service at Daybreak*
- *Bible studies, for clients*
- *We supported the adopt an angel, Father-Daughter-Dance, Care Awards, Fund Raise Golf Tournament, Reflection Hospice, Back to School Program, Celebrate Recovery, Faith & Blue coat drive, (269 coats to children of all ages), and many more programs in the community, community Council,*

We are not only a Pregnancy Resource Center, we extend our ministry and outreach to help anyone who is in need, we strive to assure each one of our clients who calls and ask for help, gets the help they need to survive. We have so many success stories about our ministry-out-reach, we cannot share all with you, we would have to write a book, Daybreak has made an impact and difference in so many families lives. We could not do this without the support of our donors. We are a 501-(C) organization and have to depend on our Churches, individual and businesses to support the Center. Our services are 100% free, as the Director I think positive and know that if we do not have it, God will provide.

A family Finds Support

We usually share news about our mothers, but this time we want to tell you about a very special case who called our helpline: The mother called looking for help for her, and her four children, ages 2 years to 9 years old. The family was being evicted from their home, the only place they could go was a cheap motel, as the father had lost his job. After finding a new job it took a few weeks for the family to get settle into a home. Our client called the Center to ask about our services, we reached out and helped the family. When they arrived at the center and told us their story with four small children, our hearts went out to this family, they were shown love, compassion and kindness. The family are now established in a home, children have clothing, shoes, food and are kept warm when it is cold. The mother shopped in our store for clothing, shoes, other items, she was in-dis-be-lief that Daybreak offered the services we provide. With the resources DBPC, provided for this family, they are settled in a home, and the children are well taken care of. The family are now in Church and the mother and father will soon be Baptized. This would not have been possible without you, our friends, who continue to support us through prayer, donations of supplies and funds. We trust in God's word; "We are His workmanship, created in Jesus Christ for good works, that God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them." (Ephesians 2:10) So we walk through these times, we will continue to do our good work and trust that we were made for these times, and the Lord will see us through.

What The Center Means to Me (Client)


