TODAY'S PROGRAM...Warm the Children

Larry French, Doug Ziesemer and Mary Stewart gave us a presentation on Warm the Children (WTC) that included the history of WTC, the financial aspects of such a charity and some thoughts for the future.



Doug took the mike first to talk about the history of WTC and our Club's involvement. We were first contacted by an Ann Arbor News reporter, Cathy O'Donnell, in 1995. She had come to Ann Arbor from the Middleton, CT area where Warm the Children was founded by Max Stewart (father of our very own Mary Stewart)

and his Kiwanis Club. He came up with the idea of using a media source, the local newspaper, to partner with in soliciting donations to purchase warm winter clothing for kids in need. Cathy saw the impact this program could make first hand and felt that Washtenaw County needed something similar. Kiwanis members at the time, including Doug himself, agreed. They started that first year with 25 families and have now grown to provide over 1,500 children with warm winter clothing every year. When Mary Stewart moved back to Ann Arbor, her involvement with WTC was crucial in keeping it alive after the Ann Arbor News pulled their support. As Doug notes, this program does so much more than just provide warm clothes. These kids get to pick out something brand new that they actually like and feel good about. They're able to get out and do things that the harsh weather may have prevented, maybe something as simple as playing in the snow with friends. They don't miss as much school and get a confidence boost that can only make their futures brighter.

Mary, Director of the Warm the Children Program, was next and talked about the other programs throughout the country. Her father, Max, has started 31 programs to date, with about half supported by local Kiwanis Clubs. Mary joked of her reluctance to accept the baton of leadership her dad is waving in her direction but, with local directors for each WTC program, we know she could do it. On a more serious note, we learned of the effects of the Ann Arbor News no longer running an ad with the coupon one could send in with a donation. Kiwanis currently runs an ad in the Ann Arbor Observer, which doesn't have the circulation but is still providing new donors to fill the gap created when the AA News left.

Mary works with 70 schools and local agencies to refer families in need. These families, in turn, must complete an application to be considered for a voucher. Once chosen, Mary works with over 220 volunteers to shop with families at Walmart. The store makes it easy by billing WTC monthly for purchases. It also helps spread word of the program when others in the store see the families shopping and using WTC vouchers (\$90 per child with no sales tax charged). This year alone the program has served 1,560 children and Mary hopes to be able to serve more next year.

Larry was last to explain the way in which monies are collected and allocated by WTC. To sum up, there are 2 pots, 1 from which operational and marketing costs are paid and 1 in which donations to the WTC program are deposited and used for vouchers. Most important to know, *no funds donated by the public are used for operations and you can be sure any donation you make will go directly to purchasing warm clothing.*
