







EdPath Success for Community College Students

The EdPath Success Study is looking for community college students wanting support for completing their studies and exploring teaching careers.

If you are at least 18 and are enrolled for fall 2025 at El Camino College, you may be eligible to participate in a program and research study exploring how you improve academically when you receive support from a community of educators.

If you enroll in the study, you will be randomly selected for one of two groups: either (a) the "program plus research study" group or (b) the "research study only" group. "Research study only" students do not participate in the program, but they still contribute to the research. Both groups get compensated!

Community college students who are willing to learn about teaching and want support from a program that offers a mentor, a Success Coach, career and learning development activities, and pay

Location

Duration

You will participate from the start of the fall 2025 semester through the end of the spring 2026 semester.

Requirements

- » Must be legally authorized to work in the United States
- Able to participate in program activities for 25 hours each semester
- » Able to complete a short questionnaire to see if you are eligible for the program and study
- » Able to complete three surveys about your college experience



Compensation

Students selected for the "program plus research study" group can get \$250 per semester (up to \$500 total) and an additional \$50 if they complete an interview

Everyone in the study can complete surveys and get a \$25 gift card for each survey (for up to \$75)
