Dr. Dan Wuori serves as Senior Director of Early Learning at The Hunt Institute, a North Carolina-based education policy resource for the nation's governors, state lawmakers and other senior state policymakers. A former kindergarten teacher and school district administrator, Dan served as the Deputy Director of South Carolina First Steps to School Readiness – the state's comprehensive, public-private early learning initiative – from 2005-2018. In this role he worked alongside elected leaders to develop significant, bipartisan support for early childhood education and oversaw system innovations including the delivery of public prekindergarten in private, community- and faith-based preschools, improvements to the state's IDEA Part C early intervention system, the creation of statewide program accountability standards, and the expansion of evidence-based home visiting programs. A Past President of the SC Early Childhood Association, Dan was honored as South Carolina's 2018 Champion for Children at the state's annual Summit on Early Childhood. He lives with his family in Columbia, SC.
