

Altar Flowers

Providing altar flowers for the Sunday service is a beautiful way to remember a loved one or express thanksgiving. If you are interested in participating, but do not know what it entails, hopefully your questions will be answered below.

People signup to provide the flowers on a Sunday that works for them. Sue, the coordinator, contacts them the month before to confirm the following:

- the date
- the florist (either Renning's or Flowers by Jerry)
- # of vases (1 or 2)
- what they would like the bulletin to say (in memory of or thanksgiving for)

A minimum of one week before their scheduled Sunday, people call the florist (Renning's or Flowers by Jerry), indicate that they are ordering altar flowers for St. Luke's Episcopal and give the following information:

- their name
- the date the flowers are needed
- # of vases (1 or 2)
- any special requests regarding the flowers
- the amount they want to spend

The florist bills the church and delivers the flowers to St. Luke's on Friday. People reimburse the church by sending a check made out to St. Luke's with "altar flowers for (date)" in the memo.
