Significance of Deeds Performed During 'Ashra-e-Dhul-Hijjah

Rasulullah Sallallaho Alyhi Wasallam said:

None of the virtuous acts performed on other days are superior to those performed during these days (i.e. the first 10 days of *Dhul Hijjah*). Saheeh al-Bukhari

Rasulullah Sallallaho Alyhi Wasallam said:

There are no days more beloved to Allah that He be worshipped in them, than the ten days of *Dhul Hijjah*, fasting on each day is equivalent to fasting for a year, and standing each night (in prayer) is the equivalent of standing on the Night of power (lailatul-qadr). Sunan at-Tirmidhi, Sunan Ibn Majah, Bayhaqi

It has reported in a hadith of Rasulullah Sallallaho
Alyhi Wasallam that one should recite tasbeeh,
takbeer and tahleel abundantly i.e.: (Musnad Ahmad,
Mu'jam al-Kabeer at-Tabarani)

Fasting on the day of 'Arafah

The Prophet is said, I seek from Allah that fasting on the day of 'Arafah may atone for the sins of the preceding and the coming years. Saheeh al-Muslim

وَاذْكُرُوا اللهَ فِي أَيَّامِ مَعُدُودَاتِ (البقرة: 203)

The 'given number of days' refer to ايام التشريق (Ayyam ماد-Tashreeq) during which it is wajib (mandatory) to recite the following takbeer:

اللهُ أَكْبَرُ اللهُ أَكْبَرُ لَإِلَهَ إِلَّا اللهُ، وَاللهُ أَكْبَرُ اللهُ أَكْبَرُ وَلِلهِ الْحَمْدُ

Hazrat Ali RaziAllah Ta'ala Anhu used to read this takbeer from the fajr of 'arafah (i.e. 9th Dhul Hijjah) until after the asr of the last day of tashreeq (i.e. 13th Dhul Hijjah).

Ulamah Kiram have mentioned that it is wajib on every person to recite it once after every salah.

Men shall recite aloud while women should recite quietly.

Virtues of Performing Sacrifice

Rasulullah Sallallaho Alyhi Wasallam said:

From the actions on the day of *nahr*, a human does nothing more beloved to Allah than spilling (a sacrificial animal's) blood. On the Day of judgement, it will appear with its horns, hair, hooves and indeed the blood will be accepted by Allah, from where it is received before it even falls upon the earth, so let your heart delight in it. (Sunan at-Tirmidhi)

The Companions of Rasulullah Sallallaho Alyhi
Wasallam asked: O Messenger of Allah, what are
these sacrifices? He responded: the Sunnah of
your father Ibrahim. They said: What is there for us
in them, O Messenger of Allah?' He said: for every
hair, an additional rank. They said: What about the
wool, O Messenger of Allah? He said: for every hair
of the wool, an additional rank. Sunan Ibn Majah

Hazrat Umm-e-Salma RaziAllah Ta'ala Anha
narrates that Rasulullah Sallallaho Alyhi Wasallam
said: One who intends to perform qurbani (sacrifice)
shall not get his hair cut or nails trimmed in the
month of Dhul Hijjah, until he sacrifices the animal.
(Saheeh al-Muslim 2:160)

A person who has not cut his hair or nails with the intention of performing *qurbani*, from the first day of *Dhul Hijjah* until the days of *qurbani*, then he may cut his hair and nails whenever he wishes after sacrificing the animal. This is because this ruling is applicable until the qurbani has been performed. It is imperative to note that as per the Islamic Shariah it is *haram* (unlawful) and a major sin to shave the beard or keep it less than the length of one's fist.

Important Masail (Rulings)

♣ So offer salah to your lord and sacrifice. (Surah al-| Kauthar: 2)

Rasulullah Sallallaho Alyhi Wasallam said: Whoever can afford it, but does not perform the sacrifice, let him not come near our place of worship.

Rasulullah Sallallaho Alyhi Wasallam stayed in Madinah for ten years performing the Udhiyah. (Sunan at-Tirmidhi)

The Ulama Kiram mention that a person who owns wealth equal to nisab has to perform Qurbani. In this nisab, gold, silver, cash and other belongings more than one's needs, will also be counted i.e. if he or she owns wealth which equals the value of 612.36 grams of silver then it is wajib on him/her to perform the Qurbani.

Method of Slaughtering

In order to slaughter an animal, one should lay the animal down on the ground facing Qiblah and recite:

إِنِّ وَجَّهْتُ وَجُهِى لِلَّذِى فَطَى السَّمَوَاتِ وَالْأَرُضَ حَنِيفًا، وَمَا أَنَا مِنَ الْمُشْرِكِينَ، إِنَّ صَلَاِق وَنُسُكِى وَمَحْيَاى وَمَهَاتِى لِلْهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ لاشَرِيكَ لَهُ، وَبِذَلِكَ أُمِرُتُ وَأَنَا مِنَ الْمُسْلِمِينَ، اللَّهُمَّ مِنْكَ وَلَكَ بِالسُمِ اللهِ، وَاللهُ أَكْبَرُ»

. One should recite the following supplication after slaughtering (if the person who performed the slaughter himself, then recite):

ٱللَّهُمَّ تَقَبَّلُهُ مِنِّي

If another person is performing the slaughter on someone's behalf, then mention the name of that person in this place: ...
اللّٰهُمُّ تَعَيِّلُهُمُ مِنْ

كَمَا تَقَيَّلُتَ مِنْ حَبِيبُلِكَ مُحَدِّدِة خَلِيبُلِكَ إِبْرَاهِيْمَ عَلَيْهِمَا الضَّلَاةُ وَ السَّلَامِ هُ



The parts of an animal prohibited for consumption include: flowing blood, penis, testicles, vulva (external parts of female genitalia), glands, urinary bladder and gall-bladder.
