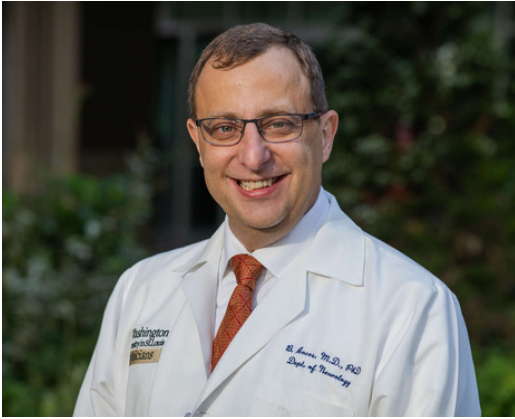


Alzheimer's Disease and Down Syndrome: How Clinical Trials are Moving the Science Forward
