Grade Level	Food Item
Kindergarten	Disposable Baking Pans to cook turkey and Boxes of Mashed Potatoes
Grade 1	Cans of Sweet Potatoes or Yams
Grade 2	Jars of Gravy and Cans of Cranberry Sauce
Grade 3	Boxes of Stuffing, Corn Bread or Pumpkin Bread
Grade 4	Boxes of Pasta or Mac and Cheese
Grade 5	Cans of Vegetables

As always, please make sure all items **are unopened and not expired**. Also, if you would like to donate a fresh or frozen turkey **please do not leave it in the food boxes** placed in the lobby.
