# Current Factors Influencing the Budget Process

- Revenue - New York State faces \$15 billion budget deficit next year
- Tax Cap
- State Aid – Governor’s Budget
- Enrollment projections have been updated by BOCES
- Health insurance costs – unknown premiums for the period between 1/1/22-6/30/22
- Retirement Rates for TRS and ERS will be estimated
- Utilities
- Salaries
- Capital Project Financing – BANs to Bonds
- Staffing needs driven by the effect of current instructional practice has on the staffing of Special Ed, AIS and ENL programs

### Tax Levy Cap Calculation

- Growth Factor - 1.0025%
- Consumer Price Index -1.23%
- March 1, 2020 - Filing with Office of State Comptroller
- Decision as to whether or not the District exceeds the

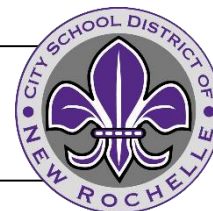

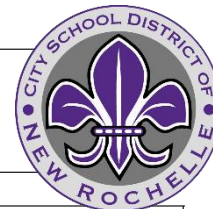
