


# *Spend an Evening Under the Stars*

*Follow the arc to Arcturus, speed to Spica, cruise to Corvus and leap to Leo. The pointer stars, Dubhe and Merak point to the North Star. Join Bruce Zeller, the planetarium director, as he helps you navigate the springtime sky. The belt of Orion will no longer help. Easter Sunday is April 17th this year because the full moon following the Vernal Equinox (March 20th) isn't until April 15th-16th.*

*On the morning of April 14th, in the eastern sky before the sun rises, from L to R will be the planets Jupiter, Venus, Mars and Saturn.*

*Remember, March comes in like a lion (Leo the Lion) and goes out like a lamb (Aries the Ram)*
