Our school district's COVID-19 Test-to-Stay Program and the PCR Saliva-Testing Program help keep as many students and staff in school as possible. In-person education is vital to our students' advancement academically, socially, and emotionally.

IF YOU GET YOUR COVID-19 VACCINE, YOU WILL:

- 1 Greatly reduce the chances that you or others around you will get infected.
- 2 Help us reach community immunity and safeguard our vulnerable neighbors.

The Test-to-Stay Program: Allows only unvaccinated students and employees who had direct contact at school with someone COVID-positive to take what is known as a rapid-result test administered by the school district. If negative, the student or employee remains in school while asymptomatic.

PCR Saliva Test Program: This test, offered in rotating weekly cycles, is voluntary for most, but mandatory for middle and high school students in sports and certain elevated-risk extracurricular activities.

Please get vaccinated and booster shots! Vaccinations are now available to everyone age 5 and older.
