

What will next summer bring? The honest answer is that we don't know. With the overwhelming positive response to our 5-night minimum operating model this past summer, longer term rentals will become the standard for June-September 2021, outside of contracted events. Opportunities for shorter summer stays will be made available one month in advance if space is available.
