



Doe Bay Spring Hiking Series with River



Everyone is invited to join Doe Bay's Resident Naturalist, River Augenstein, for a series of hikes/outings that will highlight the beauty of Orcas Island and the plants and animals that live here. Some of these hikes will have a strong focus on the flora and fauna we encounter on the trail, while others are more about the hike, the company, and the beauty.

Please come prepared with hiking shoes, water, and a spirit of adventure!

Saturday, April 23rd - Seaside Wild Orchid Hike

2.5 miles - Moderate with some elevation gains - Explore Obstruction Pass State Park with a local guide and see things you may not have noticed on your own. The Calypso Orchids should be blooming and Morel Mushrooms are often found this time of year on this trail. Many other native flowers may also be in bloom.

Meet at Obstruction Pass Parking lot at 3:30p

Saturday, April 30th - Cascade Lake Lagoon

2.5 miles - Easy. Join us for some plant and animal identification as we stroll along the lake and around the Cascade Lake Lagoon. This is an easy walk and the focus will be on finding and identifying native species of interest.

Meet at Cascade Lake Parking Area at 3:30p

Saturday, May 14th - Mountain Lake to the Cathedral Grove
