**Community HERO**

- 3% THURSDAY -**  
On the 3rd Thursday of the month, 3% of gross receipts go to the Community Hero.
- REGISTER ROUND-UP -**  
Shoppers have the opportunity to round up their purchases throughout the entire month.
- COINS FOR COMMUNITY -**  
Bring your own bag and choose where to donate your wooden coin (worth \$.05)

**Community HERO**

Organizations are eligible for the program based on their service to the community in the following areas: local community service organizations, organic food, healthy food for children or seniors, environmentally friendly and sustainable agricultural practices, human rights, environmental preservation and groups with similar missions and values.

The Orcas Food Co-op's Community Hero Program serves as an umbrella for "3% Thursdays," "Register Round Up" and "Coins for Community." Selected organizations are the recipient of funds gathered through the following:

- **3% Thursday:** 3% of the gross receipts on the third Thursday of the month.
- **Register Round Up:** Shoppers have the opportunity to round up their purchases throughout the entire month.
- **Coins for Community:** Wooden coins donated when customers bring their own bag.

The Funhouse Commons serves the urgent needs of young people and strengthens community bonds by providing a safe and stimulating environment where all can learn, discover, create, socialize, and be heard. As Orcas Island's youth-focused community center, they fulfill The Funhouse mission by providing research-based, best practices out-of-school time programming and expanded learning opportunities for island children and teens age birth to 18. Our core Afterschool, Mentor, and Education Programs support youth gains in positive social/emotional learning, affirming peer/adult relationships, resiliency, self-efficacy, skill building, and greater college/post-secondary education preparedness. The Funhouse goals are to create caring relationships, support island families, and build a healthier community.

Shop 3% Thursday or Round-up at the Register as a part of our Community Hero program. It's easy to Round Up your purchase. When your cashier asks you if you want to round up, simply say "Yes!" If you'd like to donate *more* than the roundup you can do that too. Just let your cashier know the amount you want to donate, and they can add it to your transaction.
