Guidelines for Retreats At Ferry Beach Park Association

Please....

- Respect all property of Ferry Beach as if it were your own and leave this beautiful place better than you found it. Recycle and throw away trash.
- Consume food in the dining hall and not in the dormitory rooms.
- Supervise children and teen (i.e. teen room) with an adult at all times.
- Observe all of the guidelines regarding the beach, written on a sign on the beachfront. Most importantly: swim at your own risk and always swim with a buddy. Do NOT let children swim without an adult swimmer present.
- Do not put your feet on couches, chairs, or other structures not intended for shoes.
- Respect the alcohol policy of Ferry Beach: the consumption of alcohol is restricted to the dining hall and private rooms.
- Pick up after yourself and your family.
- Do not destroy the dunes by walking on them.
- Play with toys, balls, and Frisbees that are stored in the boxes near the volleyball court and return them there when you are finished with them.
- Park in designated areas both in the Grove and on the campus.
