2023 Dr. Irving & Annabel Wolfson Lecture & Award – Dr.

Anthony B. Pinn – Sunday April 2, 2023 The Wolfson Lecture

and Award was founded in 2013 following the death of Dr. Irving Wolfson, one of Worcester's first Cardiologists. The award and lecture are named for both Dr. Wolfson and his wife

Annabel who was a well-known activist in the region. The first codicil to the last will and testament of Dr. Irving Wolfson reads in part, "The term "liberal religion" shall be defined as religion based solely on reason, and independent of supernatural revelation and tradition, and which religion advocates justice, equity, and compassion in human relations. . . Some portion of each annual lecture should be devoted to the following question: Irving Wolfson and Annabel Wolfson were agnostics who tried to live by the highest moral standards. From where does the motivation come to live by such standards to a person or persons who did not believe in a hereafter of rewards and punishments."

The Lecture is open to the public and may be attended in person or online. A reception in honor of Dr. Pinn (please see church website for full bio) will occur following the lecture.
