Students build skills in the areas of social/emotional learning, artistic expression, skill-teamwork, persistence and perseverance, fine motor, 21st-century thinking, and more.

The Jubilee Career Center for the Performing Arts Afterschool Program at Creative Hub is an EEC (Department of Early Childhood Education and Care) licensed after-school program, and we accept Massachusetts State Childcare Vouchers.
