LOCATION

Hernando County is located at the geographic center of the state of Florida, providing easy access to Tampa, Orlando & Gainesville. Located at the northern portion of Tampa Bay, Hernando County benefits as a major part of a metropolitan area yet is able to maintain a suburban and rural lifestyle.

DEMOGRAPHICS

Hernando County is one of the fastest growing counties in the country. With a population of 198,000 and a median age of 47, the county offers excellent opportunities for workforce.

WORKFORCE

A workforce of more than 300,000 within 30 mile radius. The Tampa Bay Region provides access to more than 1.3M potential employees. CareerSource, our workforce experts, can provide workforce procurement assistance to include: advertisement, recruitment, assessment, screening, interviews, hiring and training.

EDUCATION

Hernando County is taking the lead in workforce education with the new Dr. Dennis Wilfong Center for Success, a campus shared by Suncoast Technical Education Center and the Pasco-Hernando State College (PHSC). Located next to the busy American Aviation Flight Academy, flexible programs will feature high demand skills to support industry recruitments.

Post secondary institutions offering technical as well as two and four year degrees include PHSC, St. Leo University, University of South Florida, St. Petersburg College and University of Tampa.

Hernando County is home to five high schools, including a \$40M technical high school specializing in manufacturing, technology, healthcare and culinary arts. The schools offer a partnership for placement of employees and/or interns.
