### PAID INTERNSHIPS FOR ALL MAJORS

Work in Washington, D.C. or other major U.S. cities

Whether you're seeking an internship with the federal government or in the corporate sector, the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU) offers students a variety of opportunities to allow you to graduate with career experience.

For over 27 years, the HACU National Internship Program has partnered with organizations seeking to diversify their workforce.

#### Eligibility

- Be enrolled in a degree-seeking program at an accredited institution in the U.S. or Puerto Rico. Recent graduates are eligible for a limited number of internships
- Must have completed freshman year
- Must be an undergraduate or graduate student
- 3.0 GPA is recommended and not required on a 4.0 scale
- Be authorized or eligible to work by law in the U.S.

#### Travel and Housing

- Round-trip airfare for interns is arranged and paid by HACU.
- Federal interns can choose to arrange their own housing or can request HACU-arranged housing. Federal interns in HACU-arranged housing pay through payroll deductions and corporate interns pay via electronic funds transfer.

#### Federal Interns

**Pay is based on 40 hours per week.**

Undergraduate	\$610
Graduate	\$680

- Applications are accepted year-round for spring, summer and fall session internships.
- Student veterans and students with disabilities are strongly encouraged to apply.

#### Corporate Interns

**Corporate interns will be paid, similar salaries to federal interns based on 40 hours per week.**

- Resume referrals are available.
- Resumes are accepted year-round, primarily for summer internships.
- Full-time/permanent positions are also available for college seniors and recent graduates.
- Most interviews take place between August through April.

##### Spring 2020

Internship dates: January 8 - April 24, 2020

**Application deadline: October 25, 2019**

##### Summer 2020

Application opens: September 9, 2019  
Internship dates: May 28 - August 7, 2020  
(Regular Session)  
Internship dates: June 10 - August 21, 2020  
(Quarter Session)

##### Early deadline: November 15, 2019

For consideration of U.S. Intelligence Community internships and corporate internships.

**Regular deadline: February 14, 2020**

##### Quarter deadline: February 28, 2020

Later start date is only available for applicants who attend institutions that operate on a quarter calendar.

##### Fall 2020

Application opens: January 6, 2020  
Internship dates: September 3 - December 18, 2020

**Application deadline: June 5, 2020**




