Kathy Kincaid Award 2021 *Jillian Cabana*

DVCC is proud to honor Jillian Cabana as the recipient of this year's Kathy Kincaid Award for her outstanding efforts to improve the lives of domestic violence victims in our community. Jillian serves as Lieutenant of the Westport Police Department, is a Westport Domestic Violence Task Force member, and is a past board member for DVCC. Her work as a volunteer and a member of law enforcement has helped save lives and improve outcomes for countless domestic violence victims and their children in our community.

Jillian has organized many successful donation drives for DVCC's safe house residents and community clients. For example, during the pandemic, she went door to door with the help of the Westport Police Department, picking up items for basic needs drives as the police department was unable to receive donation drop-offs during the shutdown. Additionally, Jillian has helped raise awareness and educate the community about domestic violence issues, including co-facilitating workshops with DVCC during awareness months. Her work has played a vital role in creating positive change for domestic violence victims and building an informed, safer community.

Our organization

Since 1980, the Domestic Violence Crisis Center (DVCC) has provided counseling and advocacy services for victims of domestic violence and their children. DVCC is the only state-certified agency recognized by the Connecticut Coalition Against Domestic Violence (CCADV) serving the communities of Norwalk, Stamford, New Canaan, Darien, Westport, Weston, and Wilton.

DVCC's role is to help those experiencing any level of domestic violence and assist them in building a safer environment for the well-being of themselves and their families. Our services include housing and financial advocacy, legal advocacy; trauma-informed individual and group counseling; and emergency safe housing. All victim services are free and confidential, and all services offered are multicultural/multilingual.

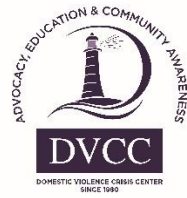
