

We are writing to seek assessors' interest for the Alberta International Medical Graduate (AIMG) Program's Clinical Assessment Placement (CAP). Placements will occur between July 5th and October 24th, 2021.

This placement offers International Medical Graduates (IMGs) an opportunity to demonstrate their clinical skills in a Canadian setting. CAP participants are selected from the eligible AIMG Program candidates who did not match during the 2021 Canadian Resident Matching Service (CaRMS) cycle.

Assessors must be:

- Practicing physicians with independent licensure.
- Practicing for more than one year.

Assessors must:

- Commit to a minimum of one 2-week block in order to appropriately assess IMGs in either hospital-based or office-based clinical environments.
- Attend a mandatory training seminar held online (tentatively scheduled for the week of June 14, 2021).

Compensation:

- As a recognition of the commitment involved in this IMG initiative, the AIMG Program provides a stipend of \$500 weekly per participant supervised.
- We are also committed to providing CME in assessor training and potential educational/professional credits.
