While many congregations are now anxiously focused on survival, we are focused on becoming more faithful. All of it is made possible by you.

All our growth, all our missions, and all our ministries depend entirely on your faith-inspired giving. Your tithes and offerings are transformed every week into worship, teaching, loving care, and help for families in need in our community. We have been called and sent to share the liberating and transforming Gospel of Jesus Christ in our age and in our time. We serve, proclaim, and minister together in this material world requiring material resources. So, we share some of our resources to fulfill Christ's ministry today. The world will not teach you this habit of sharing. It requires faith. And faith is a gift of the Spirit.

Look with eyes of faith to what God has done and is doing and in faith in and through you and through our community. Examine how you are called to participate in God's future emerging around us and how God is nudging you to participate. STEWARDSHIP SEASON 2021

Stewardship Season is upon us! Wow! Where did the summer go – it went by so quickly! Leaves are turning brilliant colors of yellow, red, and orange; and are falling off trees. It's a beautiful time of year.

Our Faith has truly taken flight during the last 12 to 19 months. Our worship services and programs are reaching more individuals than prior to the pandemic. A significant number of individuals regularly participate in online worship. Online programs that were developed during the last year continue and safe, social distanced, indoor and outdoor in-person programs are picking back up as we look for different ways to offer educational programs to adults, children and youth.

In May 2021, we opened our church building for inperson worship! It was truly wonderful seeing many of our faith family in person again! It had been TOO long! Brian and Kelley commented that it was SO wonderful to see real faces in the pews instead of photos of church members!

Our music ministry continues to enhance our overall worship experience. Throughout the summer individual choir members and musicians performed the anthem and it was wonderful listening to their beautiful music. On a sad note, Jerry Mann submitted his resignation as the leader of the Casual Worship Service to take a new position in California. FREE MONEY

Free Money: Taxpayers over 70 1/2 years of age with an IRA or a 401K/403B accounts may transfer withdrawals (up to \$100,000 per year) directly to Fairmont Presbyterian Church or other "qualified charitable organizations" and not pay tax on the distribution. Retirement savings accounts of various sorts require individuals over 72 to annually make required minimum distributions or face significant tax penalties. Those distributions are then added to your taxable income, often boosting your tax bracket. But, if you direct those distributions in whole or in part to Fairmont or other charities, those funds do not count as taxable income. This transfer method can save you significant tax dollars. As always, consult with qualified advisors to help with tax planning, but using qualified charitable distributions may be a tax efficient way for you to support Fairmont!

Feeding Our Community-2021

There is still a great need to feed families, children and youth in our community. We are still seeking donations of nonperishable food or personal items to South Dayton Food Pantry/FISH.

Southeast Food Pantry/FISH is a multidenominational volunteer food pantry based out of the Southminster Presbyterian Church. They are one of the member food pantries working with the Dayton FoodBank to provide emergency food assistance to those in need. In 2021 they are on pace to serve over 12,000 meals!

Volunteer opportunities—They are in need of 2-4 callers and 2-4 deliverers to fill time slots per month. Callers set up deliverers with clients on Monday or Wednesday mornings. Deliverers coordinate the delivery of food that afternoon. 1-2 hour commitment each time. Food Donations—They are in need of nonperishable food and personal care items. Fairmonters have been generously donating these items for some time and they are delivered to the food pantry weekly or monthly. Some examples of items needed are as follows:


