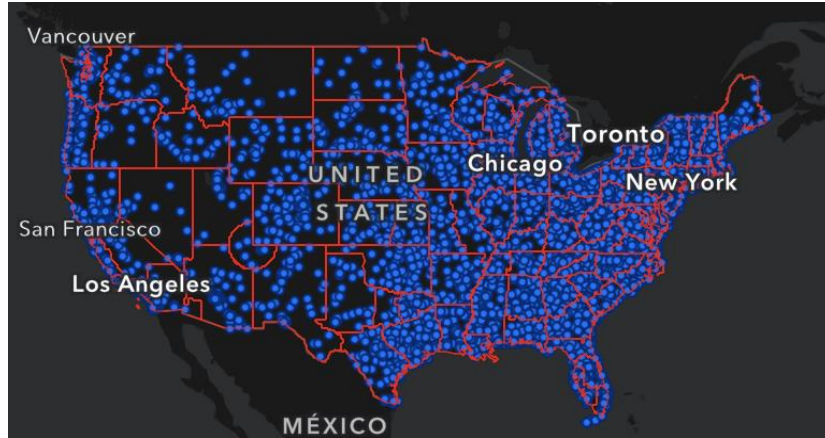


2021 Parochial Report

Filing Site is Now Open for Congregations

The [filing site for the 2021 Parochial Report](#) is now open for congregations to begin reporting their data. The General Convention Office sent an email to parish leaders with instructions on December 10, 2021.



Reports from congregations are due by **March 1st** and must be submitted on the filing site. Dioceses have until **May 1st** to review and finalize parochial reports to the General Convention Office. For the [second time](#) in the history of the Parochial Report, qualitative data is being collected through narrative questions along with the quantitative data that has been gathered historically. The Parochial Report is the oldest, continuous gathering of data by The Episcopal Church.
