The Louisiana Education Loan Authority (Lela) is Louisiana's non-profit resource for free FAFSA completion and college access, and is a division of the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (LPFA)—a non-profit public trust established to bring financing assistance and advantages to the people of Louisiana. With a focus on FAFSA completion, Lela's mission is to develop projects and programs which provide resources for college access and statewide outreach initiatives to help ensure students' success on their path to and through college. Lela specialists are available to provide virtual FAFSA Completion events statewide for high schools upon request. The Lela team also assists families one-on-one with FAFSA Completion at its College Planning Center and through its FAFSA HELPlne (see back cover). All of Lela's services are FREE!



FAFSA COMPLETION

Lela has created this Workbook just for you to help you in successfully submitting your Free Application for Federal Student Aid "FAFSA." Your Workbook includes great tips and resources, but best of all, an easy 3 step FAFSA Completion Process. Follow the 3 steps below very carefully and keep your Workbook in a safe place since it will include personal information. If any questions arise as you are working toward submitting your FAFSA, please call Lela's FAFSA HELPline at **(844) GO FAFSA / (844) 463-2372 or (800) 858-8198**. Baton Rouge area students and parents may schedule an appointment for free one-on-one assistance at Lela's College Planning Center. (see back cover for contact information.)



STEP 1: FSA ID

Create your Student and Parent FSA IDs at **fsaid.ed.gov** or on the **myStudentAid** app!



You and one of your parents (if you are classified as a dependent student) will each need an FSA ID username and password which serves as your electronic signature on the FAFSA. See page 4 for FSA ID Helpful Hints and instructions including a handy spot to record your notes.



STEP 2: FAFSA

Complete your FAFSA at **fafsa.gov** or on the **myStudentAid** app!



The FAFSA is a FREE application. Never pay to apply! You will most likely be submitting the 2020/21 FAFSA. If you plan to attend the summer 2020 semester, please contact your college to inquire if the 2019/20 FAFSA will also be required. See Page 5 for a list of items needed to file the FAFSA and for important Helpful Hints.



STEP 3: REGISTER TO WIN A \$1,000 FAFSA COMPLETION SCHOLARSHIP AT LELA.ORG

Once your FAFSA is successfully submitted, you may register for Lela's \$1,000 FAFSA Completion Scholarship drawing. Lela will award \$8,000 in scholarships monthly from October through May.

FSA ID

FSA ID ITEMS NEEDED

- Social Security Number - as printed on your Social Security Card
- Name - as printed on your Social Security Card
- Personal Email Address - Not parent's or school issued
- Cell Phone Number - personal, not shared

FSA ID HELPFUL HINTS

- Your FSA ID username and password serves as your electronic signature
- The student and one parent (if the student is dependent) will each need an FSA ID username and password
- Student and parent cannot use the same email address or cell phone number
- Retain your FSA ID in a secure location
- It is important to verify your email address and cell phone number
- Do not share this information with anyone
- Your FSA ID will be needed annually for FAFSA renewal
- Store a photo of your completed worksheet on your phone for easy access
- Once the Social Security Administration matches your information, your FSA ID can be used to electronically sign your FAFSA

FAFSA ITEMS NEEDED

FAFSA CHECKLIST CLASS OF 2020

What will I need to file my 2020/21 FAFSA?

- FSA ID - Student's electronic signature - create an FSA ID prior to FAFSA submission at fsaid.ed.gov or download the myStudentAid app.
- FSA ID - One parent's electronic signature - create an FSA ID prior to FAFSA submission at fsaid.ed.gov
- Your Social Security Number
- Your Parents' Social Security numbers if you are providing parent information
- Your driver's license number if you have one
- Your Alien Registration Number if you are not a U.S. citizen
- 2018 Federal tax information or tax returns including IRS W-2 information, for you and for your parents if you are providing parent information

- Records of untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans non-education benefits for you and for your parents if you are providing parent information
- Information on cash, savings and checking account balances, investments including real estate but not including the home in which you live; and business and farm assets for you and for your parents if you are providing parent information
- File your FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov or on the App.

FAFSA HELPFUL HINTS

- Apply for the FAFSA at the official website www.fafsa.gov. Never pay to apply!
- The 2020/21 FAFSA will be available on October 1, 2019. Tax information from 2018 will be used.
- By completing the FAFSA, you are considered for the federal Pell Grant, student loans, Work Study as well as the state-based TOPS program.
- The FAFSA takes approximately 20-30 minutes to complete if the student and parent have all of the required information at hand.
- Take advantage of the Help & Hints bubble on the right hand side of the screen for details on each question.
- You can begin your FAFSA, save it and return to it with your Save Key, within 45 days.
- The student's dependency status determines if the student will file the FAFSA as a dependent or independent student. Read and answer all questions carefully. Supporting legal documents may be requested.
- The FAFSA should only be completed by the student and/or their legal parent(s). If parents are divorced or if there is any unusual situation, review the link to the definition of "parent" in this section on the FAFSA. It does not matter who claimed the student on their taxes.
- FSA recommends using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to electronically transfer tax information into the FAFSA if possible.
- For quicker processing, electronically sign the FAFSA with your FSA ID instead of mailing a paper copy.
- Be sure to "View FAFSA Summary" before clicking "Submit my FAFSA". This is a final check for any errors before submitting.
- Print out and retain your FAFSA submission Confirmation Page. Do not delete the email notification from Federal Student Aid.
- **Verification** - *If you are selected for Verification, read all instructions carefully and provide all additional information requested to your college. Your Student Aid Report (SAR) will indicate whether or not your file has been randomly selected for verification. The SAR is typically accessed through a link sent to you by the U.S. Department of Education after you file your FAFSA. If you are selected for verification, there will be an asterisk (*) next to your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) figure on your SAR. You will be notified by your college financial aid office if your application has been selected for verification. Once your documents are verified, your application continues to be processed, otherwise it remains in a "hold" status. For more information visit tinyurl.com/verification2018.*

SIX REASONS WHY FILLING OUT THE FAFSA IS A REALLY GOOD IDEA:

- 1 It's how the government and colleges decide your financial need and award institutional aid in some cases for all income levels.
- 2 If you have all of your documents, it only takes approximately 30 minutes, and you can do it online for FREE!
- 3 You might be eligible for federal grants, which you don't have to pay back!
- 4 The FAFSA is used to award some state based aid - like TOPS!
- 5 Even if you don't think you'll need a loan, it can't hurt to have a backup plan in place. If you do borrow, only borrow what you need. Loans must be paid back.
- 6 Work-study jobs are mostly on campus, and you become qualified to apply based on your FAFSA information.

12 COMMON FAFSA MISTAKES

1. **NOT COMPLETING THE FAFSA** - If you don't complete the FAFSA, you could lose out on thousands of dollars to help you pay for college.
2. **NOT USING THE CORRECT WEBSITE** - The official FAFSA website is fafsa.gov. Never pay to complete the FAFSA!
3. **NOT GETTING AN FSA ID AHEAD OF TIME** - Create your FSA ID early to avoid any delays.
4. **WAITING TO FILL OUT THE FAFSA** - Some financial aid is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis so get it done ASAP!
5. **NOT FILING BY THE DEADLINE** - Each school sets its own FAFSA deadline so be sure to check with your school.
6. **NOT USING YOUR FSA ID TO START THE FAFSA** - Sign in the FAFSA with your FSA ID to prevent common errors and for easier electronic signing.
7. **NOT USING THE IRS DATA RETRIEVAL TOOL (IRS DRT)** - It is the fastest and most accurate way to enter your tax return information.
8. **NOT READING DEFINITIONS CAREFULLY** - Take your time to read carefully to avoid processing delays.
9. **INPUTTING INCORRECT INFORMATION** - Be sure to enter your full name as it appears on your Social Security card and triple check your SSN.
10. **NOT REPORTING PARENT INFORMATION** - Dependency guidelines are determined by Congress, not IRS. Answer all questions on FAFSA carefully.
11. **LISTING ONLY ONE COLLEGE** - List all colleges you are considering even if you haven't applied or been accepted yet.
12. **NOT SIGNING THE FAFSA** - An unsigned FAFSA is incomplete. Sign electronically with your FSA ID which is faster than mailing a signature page.
