Celebrating Revitz House Renovations

Newly affixed to Revitz House, the blue and gold mezuzah pronounced the moment--the completion of Phase III of renovations. On September 12, 2017, residents, board members, and Charles E. Smith Life Communities (CESLC) team members gathered to mark the dedication and grand opening of the new first level of Revitz House. The project included the redesign of the living room, café, and administrative offices; a new mailroom; and the creation of two activity centers.

"The transformation that we celebrate here is truly life-changing," said Aaron M. Rulnick, Board of Governors member and president of the Housing Boards. "This renovation is a testament to CESLC's mission to enhance the lives of residents."

The improvements at Revitz House started during October 2014 as a multi-year multi-phase renovation project. The residence is undergoing cosmetic,

technological, and structural upgrades. The first two phases of renovations added an ambulance accessible entry canopy and laundry rooms on each floor of the residence. During these phases, the corridors on residential floors were remodeled, the rehabilitation and wellness center was created and safety enhancements were made.

The fourth and final phase of the planned improvements will update the dining room and kitchen.

"The timing of this celebration couldn't be more appropriate," said Rulnick. "As we celebrate a new year, it is fitting that we once again begin anew."
