## TALK TO YOUR REPRESENTATIVES:

- Ask your rep to speak with Governor Newsom and advocate for a more significant increase in General Fund expenditure for K-14 (K-12 and community college) education in this year's budget.
- Ask your rep to support a K-12 public school supplement for regional cost of living in the state budget starting in 2019-2020.
- Ask your rep to support Assembly Bill 39. This bill would increase the funding targets for K-12 per-pupil spending in the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) to meet the National average.
