In my seminary classes, I have studied the powers that have come against God's earthly representative, the Church. It is amazing to note that for centuries the church has even survived in the midst of all the oppression. 
Our United Methodist Man With a Pan" will begin serving at 11:00 am. No reservations are needed, and the price is your donation.




The church office and Christian Life Center will be closed on Monday, September 2nd in observance of the Labor Day.
