O come and hear my wordless prayer,

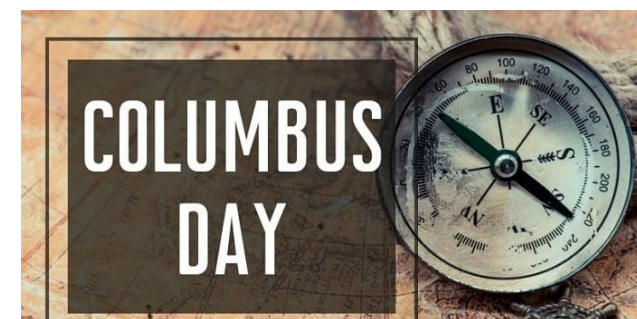
My silent plea and take them far away from me.
