Join the Purdue Wine Grape Team and fellow wine industry professionals for an international Extension excursion to northwestern Iberia!

SCHEDULE

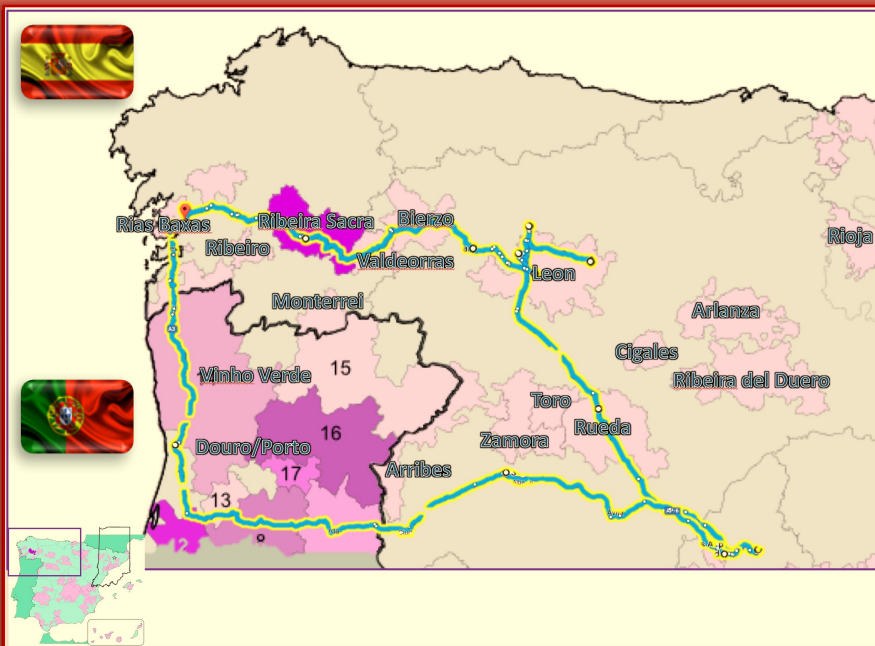
The Team will explore the wine growing appellations of northern, "green" Spain and Portugal for 10 adventurous days this coming spring/summer (June 13-22, 2017).

Arriving in Madrid, we will head northwest through the historic vineyards of Rueda toward the ancient city of León. Crossing the Pilgrim's Road to Santiago de Compostela, we will pass through the El Bierzo appellation and visit its local wineries.

Continuing through Galicia's rugged landscape, Ribeira Sacra's vineyards are next, before we will taste Rías Baixas' crisp Albariños. Reaching the Atlantic Ocean, we shall visit the fishing villages near Vigo, then enter Portugal and the viticultural area of Entre-Douro-e-Minho for an evaluation of spritzzy Vinhos Verdes.

We will stay in the old city of Oporto, a UNESCO World Heritage site, then drive up the Douro to study Port wine production and styles.

Europe's oldest university, in Salamanca, will be our last stop before we conclude our excursion with a panoramic tour of Spain's capital.



PROGRAM INFORMATION

- Deadline for enrollment is December 31, 2016.
- Course fee is \$4,500 per student incl. taxes.
- **Included** are: all transportation within Spain and Portugal (private bus with dedicated driver and tour guide), all accommodations in double occupancy rooms, all breakfasts, four group lunches and eight dinners, vineyard and winery visits, and four guided city tours.
- **Not included** are: airfare from the US to Madrid-Barajas (MAD), Spain (approximately \$1,800 from IND roundtrip), other meals, and gratuities.
- An enrollment of 20 students is required to guarantee the course.
