

Dulcimer SIG – Outdoor Practice

Guidelines for Transitional Operation

For a transitional period the Sun City Singers Chartered Club, Dulcimer SIG will conduct their “practice” sessions outdoors in accordance with CA and CDC recommendations and restrictions.

The following guidelines apply to the Dulcimer SIG:

All members of this SIG must adhere to the following protocols while using the CA pavilions.

A SIG leader (or designee) will be present at each session to monitor compliance with these guidelines. Any member observed violating these guidelines will be asked to leave and will not be allowed to return to the group until the “all clear” is given and classes resume as an outdoor activity.

All sessions will be for the purpose of class, rehearsal, or practice only. No social gatherings will be allowed.

- Classes will be limited to ten players
- The time, locations and date of classes/sessions will be scheduled thru Cindy Marsac
- Members will be advised by the SIG leaders/schedulers as to date, time and locations for each session
- Players will bring their own chairs and be positioned in a circle at least six feet apart
- At no time will more than ten persons be allowed inside the pavilion
- The leader and/or designated individual will supervise the setting up of the facility before the session(s) start and will clean/disinfect the facility when finished as needed
- Musicians are unable to play their instruments while wearing gloves. Players will not at anytime touch one another, share music, instruments, accessories, or any other item. Each player will bring their own gloves and masks. The wearing of these items will be optional provided individuals remain six feet apart and do not touch the same items of one another.
- Members will wait at their vehicles until the previous group/session has completely vacated the pavilion and directed by the leader to enter the pavilion
- Members will maintain the six foot distancing requirement at all times
- Members will bring their own chair, water, hand sanitizer, instruments, music and any other personal items necessary for class. Rigorous use of hand sanitizer will be encouraged.
- Anyone feeling ill or exhibiting signs of sickness will not be permitted to participate that day
- A daily registration of all participants will be maintained by the leader. This registration will be used to contact individuals in the event of an outbreak.
- The restroom facilities and drinking fountains are not in use at this time and participants must plan accordingly
- The pavilion tables are not to be used in any way.
