

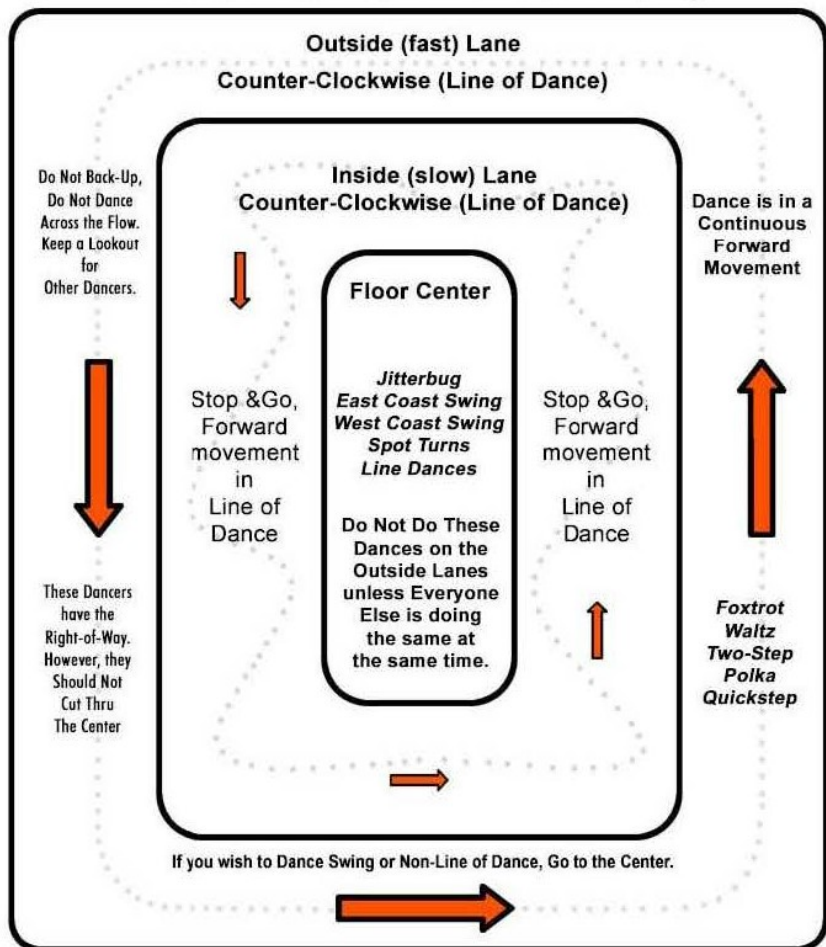
## **SPECIAL NOTE TO DANCERS:**

Please be a good neighbor and help to keep our dance floor safe by remembering these dance etiquette tips. Thank you for your cooperation!

- Dancing is done in a counter-clockwise direction on the floor (known as Line of Dance) and applies to traveling dances such as Waltz, Foxtrot, Tango and Quickstep as well as Polka and Country Western two-step. Traveling dancers move around the perimeter of the dance floor.
- Stationary dances such as Latin and Swing do not travel around the floor. Stationary dancers stay in the middle of the dance floor.
- Partner Pattern dances as part of progressive dances are done around the perimeter of the dance floor. Faster progressive dances such as two-step, polka, etc. are done on the far outside lane. Partner Pattern dances are done in the Stop & Go Lane.
- Refer to the Dance Etiquette diagram on the next page.
- If you are engaged in conversation, move completely off the dance floor.
- No unsolicited teaching on the dance floor.
- If you bump into someone on the dance floor, please apologize! It does not matter who is at fault – we are all here to have a good time!
- Sun City Texas **does not allow** dance powder, wax or dust on the ballroom floor. These substances create invisible, slippery and dangerous conditions that can easily cause injuries and falls.
