Dear Fellow Knitters and Crocheters,

We've had a fun and very busy fall. In October we had our first fashion show/luncheon with our friends from Ito yarns. What a good time it was! The sample garments were very inspiring, and I know many of you have their yarns and designs on your needles. For those of you who missed it, we now have a notebook which features many designs they shared with us. We have expanded our selection of Ito yarns both in colors and fibers. New yarns are So Kosho and Kosho (a blend of cashmere and wool), Kin Gin, a run-along sparkle yarn, and Karei, their fingering weight cashmere with a tweed fleck. We do carry every color of Sensai (silk mohair), and an expanded selection of Kinu due to Cecilia Campochiaro's Colorplay Series 2 shawl. I knit up this shawl sample, and we now have kits available to help with color choices, but feel free to choose your unique combo.
