SOE WELCOMES OUR NEW DEAN, DR. ELIZABETH OROZCO REILLY

Dr. Elizabeth C. Orozco Reilly was appointed Dean of the School of Education in June of 2022. Previously, she was the Chair and Professor of Educational Leadership and Administration in the School of Education at Loyola Marymount University (LMU) in Los Angeles, California. She is a recognized international scholar investigating women in educational leadership, and with graduate students and fellow scholars, she presents and researches globally. She works with leaders of multinationals, government, non-governmental organizations, & education on five continents. Dr. Reilly has conducted investigations in numerous countries including Afghanistan, China, Costa Rica, India, Ireland, Mexico, Pakistan, Russia, Rwanda, and Singapore with the goal of sharing stories of those that should be told. She is the recipient of many awards including American Educational Research Association's (AERA) LSJ Bridge People Award and International Studies Special Group "Outstanding Paper Award." In April 2022, AERA also honored her with its "Lifetime Achievement Award" for her international scholarship and service. While at LMU, Loyola she was honored as one of their notable professors.

Dr. Reilly earned her doctoral degree in organization and leadership from University of San Francisco and holds a Bachelor of Arts in English and a Master of Arts in Teaching from University of the Pacific (UOP) in Stockton, CA. She holds a California Commission on Teacher Credentialing certification as an English-Language Arts teacher through UOP and an Administrative Services Credential through California State University, East Bay. Prior to her work in higher education, Dr. Reilly served as a teacher and school administrator in California public schools and school districts. She has extensive higher education teaching and leadership experience in California independent and public universities, including California State University, East Bay, San Francisco State University, and University of California, Berkeley.
