

## Come walk with Jesus in the Galilee

Our Sunday readings during these weeks focus upon Jesus' preaching and healing ministries and the many miracles that took place along the shores and in the hills of the Galilee.

Join us as we explore these holy sites together through photographs and conversation.

### Sunday, January 31st

1:00 -- 2:30

Visit Capernaum, center of Jesus' Galilean ministry

We will visit the site of the synagogue where Jesus taught, discover Simon Peter's house and end at the Church of the Beatitudes, remembering Jesus' Sermon on the Mount.



### Sunday, February 7th

1:00 -- 2:30

Imagine yourself listening to Jesus on the shoreline or joining Him in a boat on the water

Explore the rocky ground of the Parable of the Sower, go out onto the Lake remembering the many Gospel stories that took place on the water. We will learn about 1st-century fishing boats and visit Mary Magdalene's hometown, site of the oldest excavated synagogue in the Galilee.



### Sunday, February 14th

1:00 -- 2:30

Walk along the beach where Jesus asked "Peter, do you love me?"

We will visit the churches that commemorate The Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes and the post-Resurrection appearance where Jesus fed his disciples breakfast on the beach. Finally, we will end our journey at the Church of the Transfiguration.
