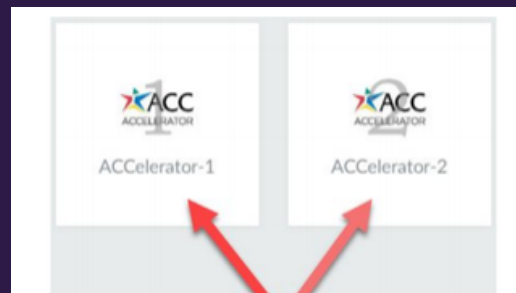
How to Log In to the ACCelerator Virtual Desktop:

Need access to software from home? Get easy access to the ACCelerator!

1. From your PC or Mac, open an internet browser (e.g. Chrome, Firefox, Safari, etc.) and go to onlinelabs.austincc.edu.

2. If prompted, enter your ACCeID and password and click **Sign In** (same login as Blackboard, MyACC, or Online Services).

3. Click either the **ACCelerator-1** or **ACCelerator-2** icon.



4. Read the agreement and click **Accept**.

5. Enter your username and password (the same password you use for MyACC).

6. If your student login is other than RBSSO, select the domain. (Hint: When in doubt, try each domain, starting with RBSSO).

7. Click **Login**.

8. Click the **HLC - Accelerator1** icon. The virtual desktop will start up and the ACC Community College District startup screen appears.

9. Click **OK**. You will be prompted to log into the virtual desktop.

10. Enter the same username and password you used to log in to the VMware Horizon page on Step 5. This is typically your student ID and password (same as MyACC).

11. Press **Enter** or click **ACCeID LOGON**. Your virtual desktop will open.

Important Tips:

- Save files to your Google Drives. All files will be deleted when your ACCelerator Virtual Desktop session ends.
- Whenever you leave your workspace, lock your desktop, preferably on your home computer. If you cannot lock your home computer desktop, lock your ACCelerator Virtual Desktop.
- Remember to LOG OFF the ACCelerator Virtual Desktop after use.
