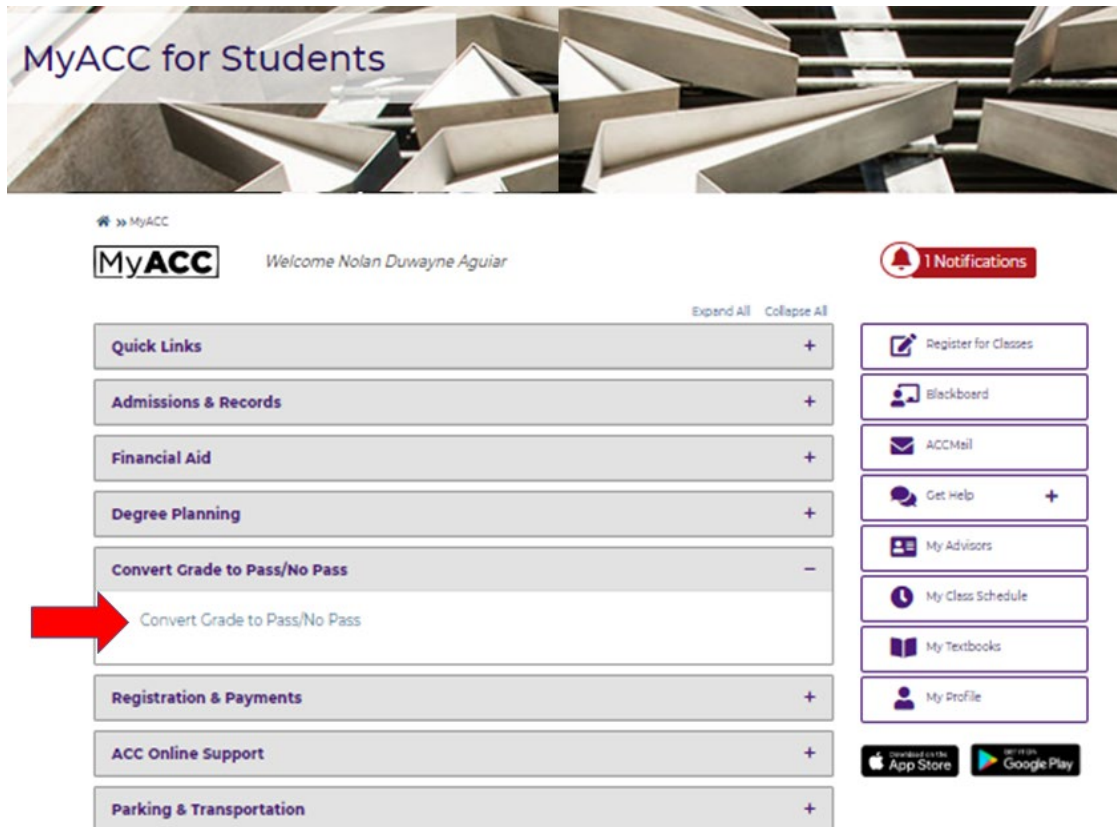


How to Select Pass / No-Pass Option Available from May 22 - May 29,2020, for Spring 2020

1. Log in to your MyACC Student Portal
2. From the Dropdown menu select Convert Grade to Pass/No Pass
3. Select **Convert Grade to Pass/No Pass**



- Select from the list of Spring/Summer 2020 courses. You may select as many as you wish to convert to P/NP.

***Please note only grades of C or better in a course may be converted to P(Pass). Grades of D and F may be converted to NP (No-Pass). Choose between the radio button for Letter Grade or Pass/NoPass. Select one or all courses option of Pass/No-Pass, save, and confirm.**
