

The California Rancher Sustainability Assessment

The CRSA is a tool developed by ranchers for ranchers, and UC Cooperative Extension, to provide a way for you to think about your management practices. The score you receive at the end is not the important part, but rather this a process that can help you assess yourself on how well you are doing with your own management practices. This tool is designed to provide insights on management practices you are doing well on, practices you are doing ok with, and areas where improvements should be considered.
