Rules:

1. Use an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of plain, white paper (e.g. copier/printer paper)
2. Make sure the paper is vertical (portrait).
3. Use the entire page for your design.
4. Fill out this sheet with your name, teacher, and grade so we know the entry is yours.
5. Attach this sheet on top of your entry, using a paper clip, and return it to the front office

- Use markers, crayons, colored pencils, paint, etc.
- You may not glue or attach anything to the page that sticks up because entries must be scanned to make the cover.
- Try to include "Lakeridge Elementary" and "2016-2017" in the design.
- Try to incorporate the theme into your design.
- You don't necessarily have to put the theme words in your design but you should try to incorporate the concept
- DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THE ACTUAL DESIGN, just on the entry form that you attach to it.

Design Tips:

- Make sure your lettering is very neat.
- Make sure everything is spelled correctly.
- Bright and vivid colors make better covers because they scan better.
- Don't put lettering or important design elements at the very edges of the page (1/4 inch all the way around) as they will get cut off when the cover is made. Your background and other parts of your picture should go all the way to the edges.
- Be creative and use your imagination!

Other information:

- Lakeridge students in any grade level may enter.
- All work should be done by the **student**, and not by a parent or older sibling.
- Entries will be scanned to produce the cover, so no changes may be made after the entries are submitted.
- Judging will be done by a committee composed of teachers/staff, and PTA.
