The Bookstore has recently updated its policy for accepting book donations. We hope this will help keep you abreast of what kind of donations we need. Here they are:

WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

- Books that are moldy, mildewed, or smelly.
- Books that are underlined, highlighted, or have dog-eared pages.
- Books that are torn, missing pages or have broken spines.
- Encyclopedias, English dictionaries, text or reference books.
- Reader's Digest condensed books.
- "Self-help" books that are 5 years old or older.
- VHS and/or cassette tapes.

WE DO ACCEPT:

- Magazines - news magazines must be dated within 2 months of the date brought in to the Bookstore.
- Current DVDs and CDs.
- Children's Books printed after 1990.
- Mass Market/Paperbacks in good condition.
- Current Fiction and Non-fiction.

IN ADDITION, WE WOULD ALSO LIKE TO ASK THAT YOU:

- Please do not leave donations in the lobby of the County Building
- Not give donations to Library Staff

There is a small card with this information you can also pick up in the bookstore. We appreciate your help in getting the word out about the changes to our policies.
