The organization known as the Scientific Special Search Party, to which Shinjiro's father had belonged, offers Shinjiro the choice – to become a new Ultraman and protect the world. Shinjiro realizes just how far the SSSP goes to protect humans from alien threats. When more powerful aliens begin to appear from the same world as first Giant of Light, Ultraman, Shinjiro begins to discover even darker secrets about his father and the SSSP. Shinjiro has to make a decision quickly whether or not to take up the mantle of Ultraman, because he is not the only one.

More than just a reboot or retelling of the classic 1960s daikaiju superhero series, Shimizu's new Ultraman is a tense and exciting new story. The modern Ultraman is a brilliant tribute to the decades-long franchise, doing justice to the original while telling its own story. It is a manga that will appeal to older fans as well as newer ones, and also combines the perfect elements of both alien and mecha Sci-Fi. The series currently has 15 volumes in English as of April 2020.
