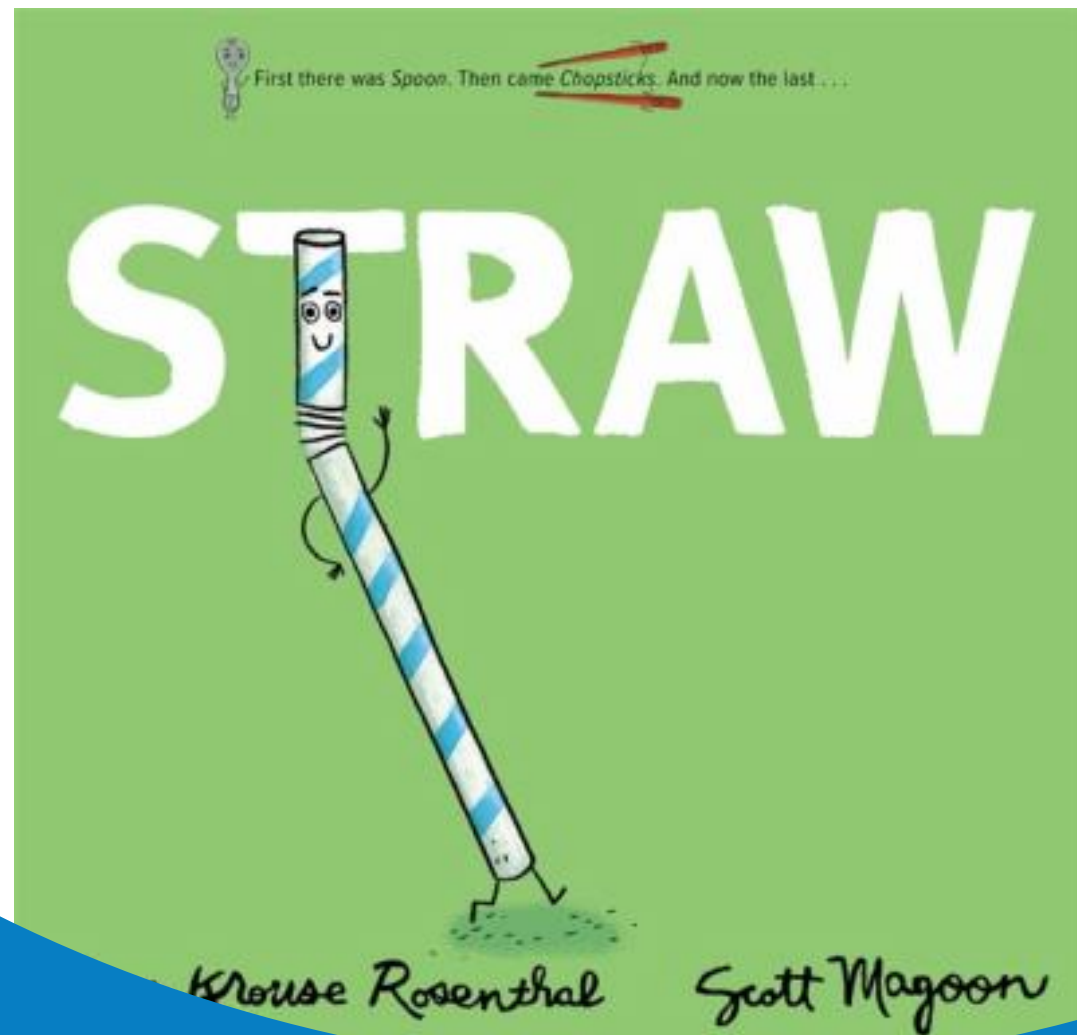

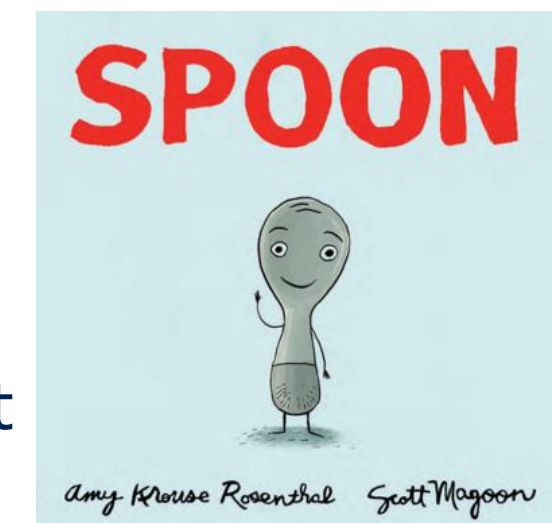


Picture Book (Funny), Children
