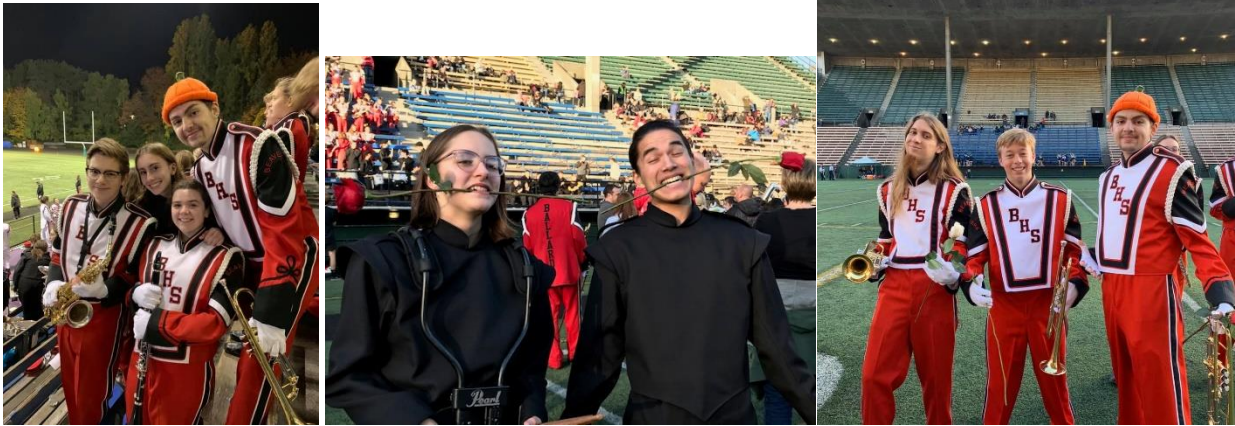


BAND BUZZ for Oct 29 - Nov 4, 2019
